



PLANNING YOUR GROUP VISIT TO BARTRAM'S GARDEN

Rates: Our group tour rates are based on a minimum group size of 10 people. If your group is composed of fewer than 10 people, you must still pay for the minimum rate for 10 people.

Payment: The deposit for your visit is due one month prior to the date of your scheduled tour or program. Lunches must be paid for in full prior to your visit. You are welcome to pay by check, credit card, or money order. Checks can be made payable to the "John Bartram Association." Please note that failure to send in your confirmation form and deposit by the requested date may result in cancellation. You are welcome to pre-pay the entire amount due before your visit, or you may pay the balance on the day of your visit.

Arrival: Please arrive at the scheduled time for your tour. If your tour is scheduled on a weekday and are running late for any reason, please call 215-729-5281 ext. 100. If your tour is scheduled on the weekend and you are running late, please call 215-729-5281 ext. 109.

Parking: If arriving by motorcoach, your driver should proceed to the Visitor parking lot, which is at the end of our driveway and to the left. The motorcoach should stop in front of the barn to allow passengers to disembark, then park in the back of the lot.

Clothing: Bartram's Garden is a natural wooded setting. Comfortable clothing and footwear are recommended, as are sunscreen and a hat to protect against sun or rain. Umbrellas and bug spray are available for purchase in our gift shop.

Dining options: Catered lunches are available for groups of 10 or more people. Groups are also welcome to bring their own lunches and may reserve one of our indoor dining spaces or our outdoor picnic pavilion for a nominal fee. Please indicate on your reservation form if you would like to reserve dining space.

Photography: Photography is allowed in both the historic home and throughout the gardens. We do ask that flash photography not be used on any of our historic fabrics or samplers.

Mobility Concerns & Special Requests: We are happy to accommodate guests with special needs or requests. If there are members of your group with mobility concerns, please let us know when making your reservation. Our grounds include some hilly terrain, as well as brick or dirt walking paths. Limited portions of the Bartram house is accessible to those with walkers or in wheelchairs. Restrooms are ADA-approved.

Cancellations: Cancellation is required two weeks prior to your scheduled visit. In the event of inclement weather on the day of your visit, arrangements can be made to reschedule within 90 days of your original reservation without losing your deposit.

DIRECTIONS TO BARTRAM'S GARDEN

Find us on your GPS! Use 5305 Harley Avenue.

- **FROM THE WEST VIA I-76 (SCHUYLKILL EXPRESSWAY)**

Travel east and south through Center City to Exit 346B, Gray's Ferry Avenue.

Bear left on exit ramp and turn left at light on to 34th Street/ University Avenue. At next light turn right on Gray's Ferry Avenue and cross Schuylkill River.

Take first left on to Paschall Avenue. Turn left at next light on to 49th Street and around bend on to Gray's Avenue. Follow trolley tracks and bear left at fork on to Lindbergh Boulevard.

Just beyond 54th Street sign and immediately after crossing railroad bridge make sharp left turn into entrance, which is not visible until after crossing bridge.

- **FROM CENTER CITY**

Take 23rd Street south below Market Street and merge right on to Gray's Ferry Avenue just beyond South Street, then follow directions above.

- **FROM DELAWARE, BLUE ROUTE, & POINTS SOUTH VIA I-95N**

Follow I-95N past Philadelphia International Airport. Take Exit 13, Central Philadelphia, 76/291 West, and continually keep to right.

Take exit for 291 West. Turn right on to Island Avenue and stay right. Cross under highway and turn right at light on Bartram Avenue and left at second light on to Essington Avenue. Proceed straight on Essington and turn left at first light on 70th Street. Go straight and turn right at next light on to Lindbergh Boulevard. Follow Lindbergh Boulevard to Garden entrance on right just after Elmwood Avenue joins with Lindbergh.

- **FROM NEW JERSEY & POINTS NORTH VIA I-95S**

Follow I-95S past Center City. Take Exit 14, Bartram Avenue, and proceed to second light at Essington Avenue. Turn right and follow directions above.

- **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

Take No. 36 Trolley from City Hall to 54th Street. Cross railroad bridge to Garden entrance on left.
