FEATURED PLANTS

Add seasonal color, fresh new scents, and attract bees, birds, and butterflies to your garden.

Native Perennial: *Pycnanthemum incanum* Hoary Mountain Mint

This vigorous growing perennial in the mint family will surely attract a plethora of pollinators to your garden. Blooming in mid-late summer this plant was described by one of our garden staff here as resembling “the bar from Star Wars” because of how many different species of insects are found dining on its fragrant sprays of white flowers. This is a great Bartram plant for full sun to semi-shade as a medium height ground cover (2-3 ft. and spreading) for large areas or as a container plant for smaller spaces.

Native Shrub: *Clethra alnifolia* Summersweet

Boasting an abundance of very fragrant white to pink flower spikes in mid-late summer, one can always find Summersweet buzzing with activity. A medium height shrub (6-8 ft.) for a sunny to semi-shady location that can take both dry and wet conditions.

Native vine: *Passiflora incarnata* Passion Vine

A hardy (yes, hardy!) twining perennial vine that has one of the most unique and interesting flowers starting in mid-late summer into early fall. Give the passion vine full sun and something to climb up and the annual floral display will surely stop you and the bees in their tracks. This does die back to the ground during the winter and emerges a tad late but by the end of the summer it is a truly reliable and marvelous vine to have in the right garden location. It also does well in container gardens.
