**Need help selecting plants? How much sun do you get?**

- Sun Plants (S): 6+ hours of direct sunlight, not shaded by a tree/building
- Part Sun Plants (PS): 4–6 hours of direct sun, plant may get some shade
- Shade Plants (SH): 3 hours of sun or less

Look for a plant's sun/shade indicator to make sure it will work for you!

Availability is continuously updated. Plants will be available as they come into season.
